ACTIVITIES

Summer: Free Stubai Super Card for free use of cable cars, entry to attractions and discounts. 850km hiking and walking trails, climbing, running, Air-Parc at the StuBay, airsoft, rafting on the Ruetz, Nordic walking, fishing, bungee jumping, Segway tours, tennis at the SPA-HOTEL Jagdhof, StuBay or Fulpmes tennis courts, paragliding and hang-gliding, freeriding and freestyling. 720km of mountain and e-biking trails with 13,000m elevation gain, special routes for extreme bikers, e-bikers and leisurely cyclists, e-bike rental and charging stations, Stubai E-Bike Sightseeing Tour and mountain bike tours. StuBay water park in Telfes for indoor and outdoor water adventures, Neustift leisure centre, Mieders swimming pool and Lake Kampler in Neustift. Mieders summer toboggan run. Five Alpine golf courses in the region – Olympia Igls, Lans, Rinn, Seefeld-Wildmoos and Mieminger Plateau. BIG Family Stubai summer activity programme for children aged 5+ and 10+.

Winter: Stubai is Austria's largest glacier skiing area, altitude: 1,695 to 3,210m, guaranteed snow from October to June. 26 cable cars, 108km pistes, 35 easy to challenging downhill runs, private ski lessons, freeride runs, Stubai Zoo snow park, Powder Department, 3S Eisgrat cable car – the Alps' longest 3-cable reversible cable car system. Free shuttle to the Glacier bus stop – 2 mins from Happy Stubai. Ski passes are sold at reception. 62km of cross-country skiing trails, 18km valley cross-country ski runs in Neustift, ice skating, 43km of tobogganing and night tobogganing runs, 80km of cleared winter hiking trails, guided snowshoe tours, curling. One of the Alps' most family-friendly ski resorts with activities at the Alpine Centre, Kinderland children's ski school and magic carpet. TOP OF TYROL viewing platform at 3,210m.

HOW TO GET THERE

By car: Take the A13 Brenner motorway. Just before reaching Italy (coming from Innsbruck), take the Schönberg exit to the Stubai Valley, continue on the B183 in the direction of Neustift until you reach Neder, turn left onto 'Pinnisweg', right onto 'Wiesenweg' and look for number 16.

By train: Innsbruck 23km

By air: Innsbruck 25km, Salzburg 200km, Munich 220km

By bus: Look for the 'Neder' stop

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
