

Open all year, except a short seasonal closure

ROOMS

27 rooms with telephone, flat-screen/cable TV, minibar with free soft drinks, desk, Wi-Fi, hairdryer, make-up mirror and bathroom amenities. A cold foam mattress provides a really good night's sleep! Most rooms offer Tyrolean mountain views. All rooms are non-smoking, some are wheelchair accessible.

Classic (from 19sqm) single, twin or double room, sleeps 1-3. Cosy rooms furnished in Tyrolean spruce wood, some with balcony, bathroom with rain shower & WC. Single/double rooms can be interconnected.

Superior (from 19sqm), sleeps 1-3. Comfortable room with sofa, bathroom with rain shower & WC, some with separate WC. Superior/double rooms can be interconnected.

Premium (from 29sqm), sleeps 2. Spacious rooms with living and sleeping areas, air-conditioning, bathroom with natural light, bath, rain shower & separate WC.

Studio (from 36.5sqm), sleeps 1-5. Spacious suite suitable for family accommodation. Bedroom, separate living room, two bathrooms with bath, shower & WC.

RATES

Rooms from €95/pn. Rates include breakfast buffet, minibar soft drinks, Wi-Fi, use of the sauna, taxes and service, excludes local tax. Half board option with 4-course dinner: €35 pp/pn. Free Wi-Fi throughout the hotel, ironing and dry cleaning, room service, business services. Pets allowed.

Restaurant ALPENrose: Sophisticated, elegant cuisine with a down-to-earth attitude, close to nature and people – in a word: Tyrolean! Opening times: Tuesday to Friday noon-2pm & 6-9.30pm. Closed on Monday and Saturday lunch time. Ofenstube: rustic ambience and great food.

Restaurant Gemeinsam.Keit: Delicious breakfast buffet with special herbal teas and slow juices available 6.30-10am, weekends 7.30-10.30am.

Private.Affair for private dining and culinary business breaks. The terrace – where sunshine, culinary delights and balmy summer nights await.

The nearby family-owned farm, the Lindhof produces free-range eggs, honey, jam, jellies, herbs, seasonal vegetables and fruit – turkey, lamb and beef are raised organically on the farm. All produce is grown traditionally, sustainably and in line with Ayurvedic principles.

Bar & lounge: Austrian and international wines, regional spirits, selected craft beers, cocktails.

INCENTIVES, EVENTS & CELEBRATIONS

Two conference rooms: Erfolg.Reich (75sqm, max. 50 pax), Privat.Affair (32sqm, max. 12 pax) – air-conditioned with natural light – room includes flip chart, pinboard, pads & pens, screen, projector, sound system, high-speed Wi-Fi, full presentation kit, ample parking in front of the hotel.

Two restaurants: ALPENrose (123sqm, max. 70 pax), Gemeinsam.Keit (69sqm, max. 40 pax)

Ofenstube: (27sqm, max. 26 pax)

Terrace. Additional event venue options include farmyard barn, meadow or 150-year-old farmhouse parlour.

Tailor-made activity options for incentives or team-building include a day on the farm, sledging with huskies, igloo building, canyoning, quad tours, caving, GPS challenges, stand-up paddleboarding and a visit to the Riedel glass factory with wine glass tasting and interactive museum.

SPA

Facilities include Finnish sauna, infrared cabin, massage showers, relaxation area and exercise equipment.

ACTIVITIES

Kufsteinerland is considered the gateway to the Alps and offers a mix of authentic customs, natural beauty and a diverse, exciting range of culture, cuisine and activities. Jogging, hiking and biking trails start right on the hotel's doorstep.

Local attractions: Tyrolean Festival Erl, Operettensommer Kufstein, the Passion Plays in Thiersee, numerous concerts and events at Kufstein Fortress and in the surrounding area • Attractions: Kufstein fortress with a museum and the largest free-standing organ in the world (daily concerts at 12pm and, in July and August, at 6pm), festive Christmas market • World-famous Haflinger horses, and regular stallion shows at Ebbs • Kaiser mountains nature reserve – in 2016, the valley of Kaisertal was voted Austria's most beautiful place by an Austrian TV studio audience • The Riedel glass factory with interactive museum, multimedia show and shop.

Summer: 400 hiking routes, 300km of running and walking trails, 200 mountain bike trails, 6 outdoor swimming pools and 6 swimming lakes, canyoning, rafting, stand-up paddleboarding, caving, geocaching, Segway rides, torchlight hikes.

Winter: 6 ski areas within SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser Brixental (284km of slopes, 21 valley runs, 90 modern lifts, panoramic views across majestic mountains to the summits of over 70 three-thousander peaks), ski touring, winter walking, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, tobogganing, ice skating, curling and sleigh rides.

HOW TO GET THERE

Located in the centre of Kufstein, opposite Riedel and close to the Kufstein Fortress.

By car via Kufstein Süd autobahn – Innsbruck 50 mins, Salzburg 60 mins, Munich 60 mins

By train – Kufstein station is a 5-minute drive from the hotel

By air – Innsbruck 80km, Salzburg 105km, Munich 130km

Transfers to and from train station and airport on request
